Since October 1, 2006, Lykele van der Broek has been a member of the Bayer HealthCare Executive Committee and is responsible for the Animal Health Division. He is also a member of the Board of Management of Bayer HealthCare AG.

Lykele van der Broek, born on July 30, 1954, is Dutch and graduated from the Agricultural University in Wageningen, Netherlands, with a Master of Science degree specializing in Phytopathology and Business Administration.

Van der Broek started his career at the Plant Protection Service of the Netherlands. From 1984 to 1991, he acted as Deputy Director and Director of the Netherlands Inspection Service for Arboriculture (NAKB). He then held different positions in BioScience companies. After joining the vegetable seed group Nunza (now Nunhems) in 1999, he was responsible for the Asia/Pacific region and strategy. In 2001, he became CEO and retained this position after Bayer's acquisition of Aventis CropScience in 2002. In 2003, he was appointed Head of BioScience, a business group within Bayer CropScience, before changing into the position as Head of Regional Coordination Europe at Bayer AG.
